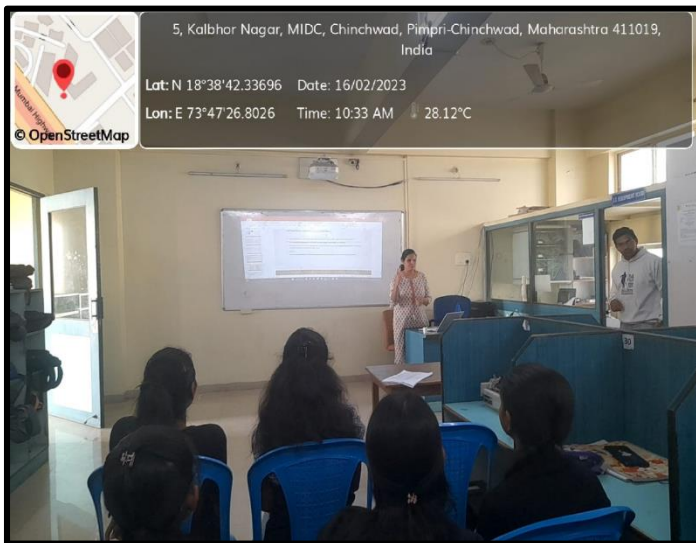

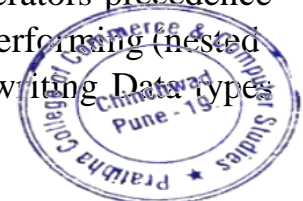
Report on “30-Hours Training on Soft skill & communication skills/Communication skills for manager”
