"Online Poster Competition on NEP2020"



The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) is the first education policy of the 21st century and aims to address the many growing developmental imperatives of our country.

PURPOSE

The basic aim and objective of NEP 2020 are to make education universally accessible from primary to secondary level by the year 2021.

IMPORTANCE

The importance of NEP 2020 is to transform the Indian education system by making it more flexible, future and relevant in the changing world of 21st century.



CAREER

The NEP 2020 provides a solid foundation for implementing career guidance in schools. By adopting the NEP's recommendation, schools can empower students to make informed choices about their future careers and enable them to reach their full potential.

CHANGES

The new NEP is based on the following key areas: Access, Quality and Accountability. It also focuses on the following changes: 1. Multi-disciplinary and interdisciplinary learning. 2. Use of technology in school education. 3. Annual assessment system. 4. All India Council for Technical Education (AITEC).

GOALS

It will increase the Gross enrollment ratio in higher education to 50% by 2035. A big emphasis of the new policy is on the usage of technology in order to improve accessibility.

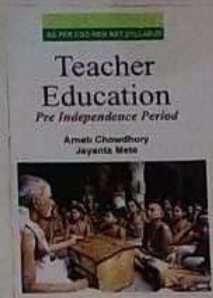
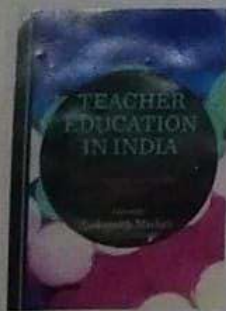
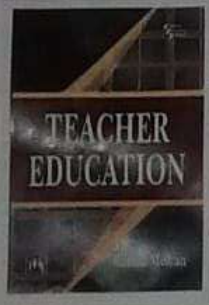
Difference between today's education and the old education system

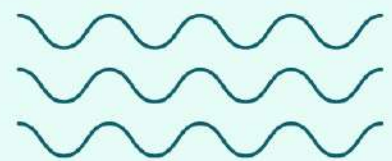
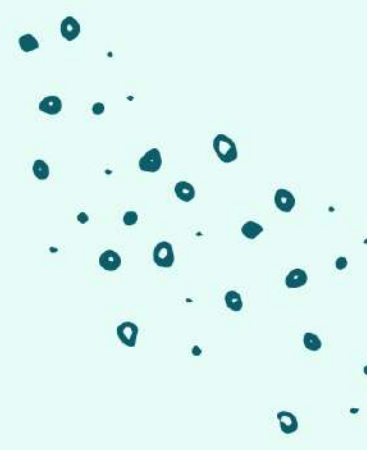
