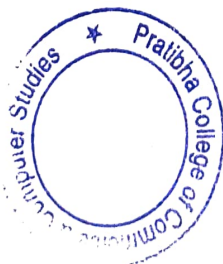
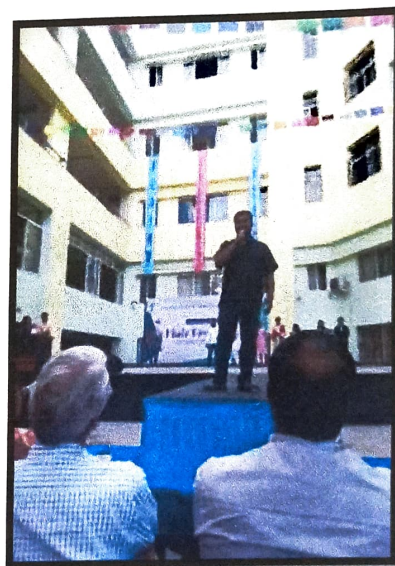
The objectives of the Competition were as follows:

The Sports Committee, in coordination with the Alumni Committee, ensured meticulous planning and execution.

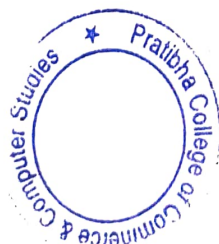
