

<u>Industrial visit & Excursion Committee Report (2017-2018)</u>

- 2. To bring connectivity between Academia and Corporate through the channel of Industrial Visit, thus to facilitate the journey from College to Corporate.
- 3. To revitalize the students by incorporating fun activities through the means of Excursions and outings.

As a convenor, I – Dinesh Lahori, on behalf of the entire Committee – wish to express my kind gratitude to the each and every member of KES family – including Higher authorities, Admin staff, the respective Course Heads and their members for directly and indirectly contributing to bring in successful execution of 10 Industrial visits and Excursions for bringing the desired exposure of Corporate to Academics. Thus the few highlights are mentioned as below:

- FY & SY BSc Industrial Visit to Satara was scheduled and executed on 18 November 2017 – Milk Industry, Sugar Industry and Anand Farm House for FY and SY BSc Students (44 students) and 05 faculty members. The visit was executed through Agri Tourism Company at the cost of Rs 600 including Breakfast, Lunch, Transport and Farm activities, DJ, Water activities.
- 2. <u>Industrial Visit of SY B. Com to Bhimashankar</u> was scheduled and executed on 12 January 2018. The spots included in the trip were Amul Dairy Rajgurunagar, Onion and Garlic Research Center, Rajgurunagar and Bhimashankar Temple at the cost of Rs 675 through Crazy Holidays Package including Breakfast, Lunch, Transport and Evening Snacks. The total strength of 72 students and 5 faculty members accompanied the trip.





- 3. Excursion of TYBBA and TYBBA IB to Mahableshwar was scheduled and executed on 24 January 2018. The spots included in the trip were different sightseeing places of Mahableshwar like Mahableshwar temple, Table point, Arthur's Seat, Mapro Garden, Mahableshwar Market etc. at the cost of Rs 430 per student including only Transport and Transport toll taxes through Choice transport for Rs 13000 for entire day. The total strength of 40 students and 4 faculty members accompanied the trip.
- 4. On 01 & 02 Feb 2018, <u>An Industrial visit cum Training workshop on Networking</u> for BSc (55) and BBA CA (35) students, faculty members was scheduled and executed to I-medita Center, Baner. The intention of the same was to provide an practical exposure to the participants on the Networking applications tools. The total strength of 90 participants (excluding faculty) participated in the same through transport service of Choice Transport at the cost of Rs 5500 per day and student contribution of Rs 225 per student.
- 5. <u>Industrial Visit of SY. BSc (CS) to Rajgurunagar and Junnar</u> was scheduled and executed on 03 Feb 2018. The spots included Agro farm in Junnar, Amul Industry Rajgurunagar and Onion & Garlic Research Center Rajgurunagar, at the cost of Rs 700 per student including Breakfast, Lunch and Transport through Crazy Holidays Package. The Total strength of 53 students and 3 faculty members accompanied the trip.
- 6. <u>Outstation Management Training Program of NSS students (10)</u>, <u>Sports excelling students (15)</u> and <u>MSc CS students (41)</u> to <u>Kusur Pathare</u>, <u>Klandi</u> on 03 Feb 2018. It was entirely College sponsored and the transport for the same was organized through Choice Transport.
- 7. <u>Industrial Visit of TY B. Com to Baramati</u> was scheduled and executed on 05 Feb 2018. The spots included Nandan Diary Baramati, Cotton King Industry Baramati and Agri Tourism Farm Palshiwaddi; at the cost of Rs 700 per student including transport, Breakfast, Lunch, Fun & DJ activities at Farm through Agri Tourism Package. The total strength of students 42 students and 3 faculty members accompanied the trip.
- 8. <u>Industrial Visit of SYBBA and SYBBA IB to Bank of Baroda, PCMC Corporation Branch</u> was scheduled and executed on 15 Feb 2018. The total strength of 80 students and 04 faculty members accompanied the trip and Mr Bharve (Branch Bank Manager) attended the students to explore the different financial Banking trends.





- 9. Staff Excursion to Morachi Chincholi Jai Malhar Krishi Kendra was scheduled and executed on 17 February 2018. The spot included Fun and adventure activities like walking on Rope, Hanging bridge, Rides, Puppet show, Rain dance, Swimming and many more with the delicious 3 meals and drinks. The trip was partly sponsored by College and the faculty members through Choice Transport. The total strength of 47 faculty members comprising from KES family accompanied the trip.
- 10. <u>Industrial Visit of SY BBA and SY IB to Baramati</u> was scheduled and executed on 24 February 2018. The spots included Cotton King MIDC, Baramati, Nandan Dairy, Baramati and Agri Tourism farm, Palshiwadi through Agri Tourism travels at the cost of Rs 600 per student including of Transport, Breakfast, Lunch, Fun activities, DJ, and Evening Snacks. The total strength of 38 students (SYBBA), 45 students (SYBBA IB) and 7 faculty members accompanied the trip.
