As a convenor, I – Dinesh Lahori, on behalf of the entire Committee – wish to express my kind gratitude to the each and every member of KES family – including Higher authorities, Admin staff, the respective Course Heads and their members for directly and indirectly contributing to bring in successful execution of 15 Industrial visits and Excursions during 2018-19 for bringing the desired exposure of Corporate to Academics. Thus the few highlights are mentioned as below:

- 1. <u>Outstation Management Training Program of MSc CS students (41) and 4 faculty members to Kusur Pathare, Klandi</u> on 01 Sept 2018. It was entirely College sponsored and the transport for the same was organized through Choice Transport.
- 2. <u>Industrial Visit of SYB.Com and TYB.Com to Bank of Baroda, PCMC Corporation Branch</u> was scheduled and executed on 20 Oct 2018. The total strength of 35 students and 03 faculty members accompanied the trip and Mr Bharve (Branch Bank Manager) attended the students to explore the different financial Banking trends.
- 3. 27 students sourcing from FYB.Com, SYB.Com, TYB.Com visited to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Ganeshkind, Pune (SPPU) on 29 November 2018 to Department of Commerce, Department of Incubation Center, Department of International Study Center and Jaykar University Library. The trip was entirely student sponsored and the trip was accompanied by 4 faculty members.








- 4. Excursion of PCCCS Vocational training program was executed on 26 December 2018 to Mahableshwar. The spots included in the trip were different sightseeing places of Mahableshwar like Mahableshwar temple, Table point, Arthur's Seat, Mapro Garden, Mahableshwar Market etc. at the cost of Rs 700 per student and the total strength of 18 students and 1 faculty member accompanied the trip.
- 5. SY BSc CS and TY BSc CS students visited to Precision Engineering Services, CarPro Clindox Company on 28 Dec 2018 in Pune. After the Industrial exposure, the students were taken to the Khadakvasla suburbs for fun and synergy games. The total strength of the students was 76 and accompanied by 5 faculty members.
- 6. <u>SYBBA students visited to Ador Welding Company in the month of January 2019.</u> The visit was executed through the personal transport of the students and the total strength for the trip was 27 students and three faculty members.
- 7. Study oriented field visit of FYBSc and SYBSc Regular was scheduled and executed on 17 Jan 2019 to Rajgurunagar, Junnar, Nane Ghat. The spots included in the trip were Nane Ghat geographical area, Ojar Ganpati temple, Gypsum Garden, Ginger garlic research center, Rajgurunagar and Amul Diary plant, Rajgurunagar. The total strength of the students was 78 students and 05 faculty members.
- 8. Industrial visit of SYBBA –IB was scheduled and executed on 18 Jan 2019 to Ranjangoan with 45 students and 04 faculty members. The spots included the Amtek Industries and Caporo Market, Ranjangoan. The transport for the same was executed through Choice Transport. Further in the next week, another Industrial visit was organized to Milkmade Bakery, in the vicinity of the College. The basic purpose of the visit was to explore the insights of the food industry. The total strength for the industry was 33 students, accompanying 3 faculty members.
- 9. SYBSc Regular students visited District Office of Statistics and Honey Bee Research Center, Shivajinagar on 24 Jan 2019. The total strength of the students was 20 and accompanied by 04 faculty members. The entire transport was executed through the channel of Pune Public transport.
- 10. <u>Service Industrial Visit of B.Com to Sinhagad Shrushti</u> was scheduled and executed on 04 Feb 2019. The total strength of the students was 40 from FY, SY and TY B.Com. and 04 faculty members respectively. The basic purpose of the visit was to yield the practical knowledge about Service Costing in the Service Industry.
- 11. SYBBA (Regular) Industrial Visit to Baramati was scheduled and executed on 16 Feb 2019 Someshwar Sakkhar Kharkana, Waste Management plant, Power Generation plant (58 students) and 05 faculty members. The visit was executed through Choice Transport and it was financed by the College. The proposed visit







had been also scheduled to include CottonKing Industry, Baramati and Paper Mint clothing Pvt Ltd, Baramati. But unfortunately the visit could not executed further, due to mishap on the way in Korhade Budruk (20 Kms away from Baramati)


