- a. 11<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019: On the opening day of the series Mrs. Kranti Waghmare from Garware College, Pune spoke on “Maharashtratil Dushkal ani Jalsampattiche Sanvardhan”. The Speaker shared her views on the same. In the interactive session, the students expressed their innovative ideas about water conservation.
- b. 12<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019: Dr. Nanasahab Pawar, Dept. of Marathi, Annasaheb Waghire College, Saswad, and Pune spoke on the Book written on the life of Yashwantrao Chavan “Krushnakaath”. He enlightened the students with the autobiography of Yashwantrao Chavan in brief. He discussed the contribution of Yashwantrao Chavan in the social and political development of Maharashtra by mentioning various incidents in the life of Yashwantrao Chavan. The brief of the sessions is as follows:

After inaugural function, Dr. Santosh Dastane, a renowned faculty of Economics delivered a Keynote speech on ‘Critical Review of Economic Reforms’. The speaker touched to every possible area related to the subject with the help of statistics.


Dr.Mansi Kurtkoti, Dr.D.Y.Patil College of Commerce, Pimpri, spoke on ‘The Effects of LPG on Indian Economy’ in second session. Dr.Mansi has discussed various examples of our day to day life related to LPG effects with the students. Both sessions were very interactive.

In third session, Dr. Manjusha Musmade, Department of Economics, Nowrosjee Wadia College, Pune enlightened the students on the topic ‘Review of Economic Reforms on Industrial Sector’. A great discussion with the students has been done in the session.
